

Preschoolers celebrate spring with art workshops at the Highlands Museum & Discovery Center

The Highlands Museum & Discovery Center, in partnership with the Arts Council of Northeastern Kentucky, is celebrating spring with Every Child Is an Artist.

Every Child Is an Artist is designed for 3-5 year olds. Sessions are on Fridays beginning April 17 through May 15 from 12:45 – 2:15pm. The playgroup, designed for the preschooler and their caregiver, features direct exploration in the basic elements of art. Classes are held at the Highlands Museum & Discovery Center, 1620 Winchester Ave, Ashland KY.

Projects have been chosen to enhance such skills as eye-hand coordination, small muscle development, problem solving and decision making. The playgroup will do art projects, have a brief story time and enjoy playtime in the Discovery Center each week.

- May 8 Frida Kahlo
- May 15 Jackson Pollock Abstracts
